Essential Duties and Responsibilities includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Develops and manages new and existing partnerships with customers to achieve expected sales goals.
- Completes customer and field (project) assessment, ensures designs and proposals are completed in a timely, professional and accurate manner.
- Conducts presentations of proposals, project updates, invoicing and system operation including filters, valves and controllers as needed.
- Coordinates with Sales Administrator to provide purchasing department and warehouse accurate and timely material requirements, as well as coordinating job site deliveries with proper maps, dates, etc.
- Manages crew resources effectively to ensure cost-effective job progress and timely completion as per customer promise dates.
- Proactively manages all job related costs to achieve target profit margins.
- Ensures all jobs and sales orders are invoiced accurately and in a timely manner according to the billing policy for deposits, progress and final billings ensuring all costs, add-ons and proper mark-ups have been applied.
- Completes all required reports and documents as required and associated with performance of job duties and office requirements.

Physical Requirements:

The physical demands listed are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of the job. Working Conditions:

This position functions outdoors and indoors in an office, warehouse and field environment with some risk of exposure to moving equipment and moderate noise levels. Outside travel is required.
